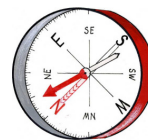

Jr. Trail Guide trainees play fun, creative learning games that teach outdoor safety, natural sciences and cultural anthropology, before hitting the trails to learn and practice safe exploration techniques.
